### NOTIFICATION

This is in continuation to the notification dated September 15, 2020 for downloading of Admit Card for the AILET 2020 to be conducted on September 26, 2020 from 11.00 hrs to 12.30 hrs for admission to B.A.LL.B.(Hons.)/LL.M. and Ph.D. Programmes offered by the University.

Due to some technical/ software problem, all candidates could not exercise their option for selection of City and Centre of Test, on first come first serve basis, at the same time. This office & NTA office has received a number of representations from candidates that by the time, the problem was rectified, the seats at some of the cities had already exhausted. Thus such candidates were deprived from their fair and equal chance. Further the number of seats at some of the Centres have also been increased by N.T.A., keeping in view the representations received from candidates. To give fair and equal chance to all the candidates for selection of City and Centre of Examination, it has been decided to cancel all the provisional admit cards downloaded by the candidates till 14:00 Hours 18.09.2020. Thus, the admit card downloaded till 18.09.2020 **stand cancelled** and will not be valid for appearing in AILET-2020.

**The system will be reset and shall be functional from 10.00 a.m. on 19.09.2020. and all the candidates are required to Select a Test Centre of their choice and download fresh admit cards from 10.00 a.m. on 19.09.2020 to 8:00 am on 21<sup>st</sup> September, on first come first serve basis. The Link, the Login ID & PW shall continue to be the same as was communicated by the NTA to all.**

To the left side of this page, you will view some of your Application details.

The next page, you will observe, names of different states, cities, concerning Test Centres and their addresses, where you can take the Test. Adjacent to the Centre name, you will observe the number of Seats available at that Test Centre. A Test Centre shall get occupied following First Come First Fill basis and the next person selecting the same Centre will observe the number of remaining seating capacity, he/she can choose from.

NTA is offering you NTA automatic Centre selection and Admit Card Generation system.

Kindly choose a State, City & Centre of your choice as per the list. Centers are based on the availability of seats and once you confirm your choice of Test Centre, submit your choice and your Provisional Admit card shall get generated. You are required to keep a copy of the provisional Admit Card, take a printout and reach the Test Centre before the time mentioned in your Admit card.

It may, so happen that the best choice of your City & Centre has got exhausted, therefore, it is recommended to continue exercising your next best city & Centre choice and get the provisional Admit Card Generated, as soon as possible.

Now, as the city and centre selection will be done by the candidate only. The city & centre of examination is opted by the candidate will not be changed further.

Kindly note due to unforeseen circumstances, even after having got provisional Admit Card issued and due to the COVID-19 situation prevailing in the country, a Test centre may have to be withdrawn. In that case an alternative, city, Centre shall be offered by NTA, as final Centre, where you will be asked to take the Test.
