ADDENDUM TO THE REVISED ADMISSION NOTICE

In continuation to the **Revised Admission Notice** published in the Newspapers/website on 01.07.2020/30.06.2020 pursuant to the [orders of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed on 29th June 2020 in W. P. \(C\) 3454/2020 Balvinder Sangwan & Ors Vs. State \(GNCT\) of Delhi Through Chief Secretary & Ors.](#), it is hereby notified and clarified that the vertical reservation of 22% for OBC category and 10% for EWS shall continue to apply to the seat matrix for the present academic year. Accordingly, the number of seats and reservation for B.A.LL.B.(Hons.), LL.M. and Ph.D. Programmes will be as under:

B.A.LL.B. (Hons.)- Five-Year Programme

Eligibility: Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2 System) or Equivalent Examination with 50% marks. The candidates appearing in the 12th standard in main annual Examination can also apply.

Total Seats: 110+10 [110 Seats on merit through All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) and 10 Seats for direct admission to Foreign Nationals on merit (**5 seats for Foreign Nationals & 5 seats for OCI/PIO**)]. Foreign Nationals are exempted from AILET. Foreign Nationals to be eligible should have obtained 65% marks in the qualifying examination.

Reservation: 22% OBC candidates, 15% for SC candidates, 7.5% for ST candidates and 10% for EWS candidates. 5% Horizontal reservation of seats for Persons with Disabilities.

Note: One additional supernumerary seat for Kashmiri Migrants. Two additional supernumerary seats for Residents of Jammu & Kashmir.

LL.M.-One-Year Programme

Eligibility: LL.B. or an Equivalent Law Degree with 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/ Persons with Disabilities). The candidates appearing in final year LL.B. main Examination can also apply.

Total Seats: 80 [70 Seats on merit through All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) and 10 Seats for direct admission to Foreign Nationals on merit (**5 seats for Foreign Nationals & 5 seats for OCI/PIO**)]. Foreign Nationals are exempted from AILET.

Reservation: 22% OBC candidates, 15% for SC candidates, 7.5% for ST candidates and 10% for EWS candidates. 5% Horizontal reservation of seats for Persons with Disabilities.

Note: One additional supernumerary seat for Kashmiri Migrants.

Ph.D.-Programme

Eligibility: LL.M. Degree with 55% Marks or its Equivalent (50% in case of SC/ST/ Persons with Disabilities). For detailed eligibility conditions visit University website www.nludelhi.ac.in.

Total Seats: 8+2 [8 Seats on merit through All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) and 2 Seats for direct admission to Foreign Nationals on merit of evaluation of Research Proposals. Foreign Nationals are exempted from AILET (Total number of seats may vary).

The last date for submission/withdrawal of applications is also extended upto 11th July, 2020. They can apply online on payment of requisite fee along with copy of requisite Caste/Persons with Disabilities Certificate through: <http://nludelhi.admissionhelp.com>, <http://www.nludelhi.ac.in> up to July 11th, 2020.

Note: Due to increase in number of seats in BA.LL.B.(Hons.) Programme and availability of limited Hostel accommodation, preference will be given in Hostel allotment to the students coming from outside Delhi/NCR. The students from Delhi/NCR will be considered for Hostel allotment subject to availability of accommodation after allotment to the students from outside Delhi/NCR.

For LL.M. programme, the University, due to non-availability of hostel, will not provide the Hostel facilities to male students admitted in the LL.M. Programme. However, the female students from outside Delhi/NCR may be considered for allotment of hostel accommodation subject to availability and hostel fee will be deposited by concerned student separately. There will not be any hostel facility to the students in the Ph.D programme. The above is as per the previous year policy.

All other details will be same as notified in the admission notice published on 30.06.2020/01.07.2020
