Ph.D. Programme AILET 2019 Results

Admission to the Ph.D. programme of National Law University, Delhi is based on a three-tier system

1. Clearance of AILET / exempted in case of UGC NET/JRF/SLET and M. Phil;
2. Clearance of Research Proposal by Scrutiny Committee;
3. Clearance by the Doctoral Committee based on the presentation of Research Proposal

The candidate shall secure minimum 50% marks (40% in case of SC/ST candidates) in the written test to qualify for submission of research proposal. The qualified candidates will be asked to submit their Research Proposal for scrutiny. The University has the right to keep the seats vacant if sufficient numbers of candidates with minimum cut off marks are not available.

The list of candidates who qualified AILET 2019 and list of candidates who are exempted from AILET (candidates with UGC NET/JRF/ SLET and M.Phil.) is uploaded on the University websites.

All qualified and exempted candidates, who fulfil the requisite academic qualifications, shall submit research proposal as per the [guidelines available](#) on the University website. The proposal shall be submitted by email only at phd@nludelhi.ac.in in Pdf. Format. All such proposals would be examined by a Scrutiny Committee. The Scrutiny Committee shall recommend three times candidates to total seats available on the basis of merit. These candidates would be called to make a presentation before the Doctoral Committee on the proposed topic of research on a date notified by the University. The last date for the submission of research proposal is **July 15, 2019**.
